### **Scholarship Scheme**

#### **Report**

The free bus pass scheme was considered by the National Service scheme of our Bhagwan Baba Arts and Commerce College so that the students in rural areas should have financial problems while studying in higher education .There are free pass on behalf of the government till 12th, but this facility is not for senior college. The free bus pass scheme was considered to prevent students from pursuing higher education. Principal of this college, The idea came from the fertile head of Dr. S.G .Bade and Dr. S.H. Gitte. The idea was echoed by all the professors at the time the senior college professor spoke. The expenses were also raised by senior college professors. Initially, 40 eligible Girls students were selected after taking the instructions .She took the application from her and asked her to fill it with her parents. In a village where there is no bus facility, the amount of distance falls in the distance. How much does it cost to spend approximately six months and divide the cost into the same amount by the senior college professor? The program was organized to inform the community about the details of the scheme.

The program was presided over by Dr S.G.Bade, Principal of the college .The Chief Guest was Taluka Veterinary Medical Officer, Dr. Snehlata Gaware, R.S.P. Taluka President Gajanan More, and Pawan Sharma. At the beginning of the program, the images of Bhagwanbaba Baba and Savitribai Phule were worshiped. Dr. S.H.Gitte stated the intention behind the scheme .Explaining his views, Taluka Veterinary Medical Officer Dr. Snehlata Gaware welcomed our plan and asked the students to take advantage of the scheme. After that, our plan was liked by the journalist Pawan Sharma and it also cost a student. Principal of the college, Dr. S.G Bede, said, “Students should serve the higher positions like Dr. Snehlata Gaware, a veterinary officer, taking advantage of our plan.

The program was organized by Prof. Vitthal Bhanus and and Prof. Ashwin Rathod have vote of thanks. The program was attended by all the college staff. The national anthem concludes the event.

40 students were selected for this scheme and their monthly expenses were between 9000 to 10000. A notebook for the scheme was prepared and the student's registration was taken every month. The scheme was spent between 9000 to 10000 months for seven months.

## **Terms and Conditions**

- 1) This scholarship is for girls who are studying in senior college and in rural areas.
- 2) In this case the bus or travel fare will be paid in cash.

For this, the presence of girls must be 75%.

- 3) This scholarship will be approved for all college girls applying for the scholarship.
- 4) To approve cash for travel fare for girls in villages where bus facility is not available
